Grading Scale

GPA Method

Unweighted GPA: 4.0 scale.

Weighted GPA: Honors and Advanced courses receive +0.5 GPA; Advanced Placement (AP) or equivalent dual-enrollment courses receive +1.0 GPA.

Both unweighted and weighted GPAs are reported on the official transcript.

Course Level Weighting

CP (College Preparatory): Standard level, no weighting.

H (Honors): More rigorous coursework; weighted +0.5 GPA.

Advanced: Includes extended research, oral defenses, and higher expectations; weighted +0.5 GPA.

AP (Advanced Placement/Dual Enrollment): College-level coursework; weighted +1.0 GPA.

Transcript notations:

H = Honors

A = Advanced

AP = Advanced Placement / Dual Enrollment

R = Repeat

I = Incomplete

W = Withdrawn

Class Rank Policy

Summit serves small, selective cohorts. To protect privacy and reflect the nature of the program, Summit does not compute class rank. Upon request, GPA distributions or percentile bands may be provided.
