Mission

Summit College Preparatory School provides U.S. online education for gifted and multilingual learners. Where learning is personal and education is global. Students are prepared for direct transition to selective universities through rigorous coursework, extended world language study, and ethical scholarship documented through oral defenses and curated portfolios.

Institutional Overview

Founded May 2025; first academic year began August 2025.

Florida, United States (Eastern Time Zone).

501(c)(3) nonprofit public charity; EIN 35-2902478.

Live online instruction delivered via Zoom Pro and Microsoft Teams; records and assessments managed in Microsoft 365 enterprise.

Accreditation not yet held; eligible for candidacy after three years of operation.

Academic Program

Instructional year of 194 instructional days.

Academic week is five days for the 22-credit and 24-credit diploma pathways; six days for the 26-credit pathway.

Graduation requirements are 22, 24, or 26 credits depending on diploma pathway.

English, mathematics through advanced study, laboratory sciences, history and social sciences, and

sustained world language study form the core program. All students complete a minimum of six courses per year with Individual Learning Plans and documented mastery.

Diploma Pathways

Standard Diploma (22 credits). A balanced, college-preparatory curriculum with mastery of core outcomes; five-day academic week.

Honors Diploma (24 credits). Sustained Honors and Advanced coursework with elevated performance thresholds and extended readings; five-day academic week.

College-Preparatory Diploma – Advanced (26 credits). Sustained advanced study, extended world language sequence, and a thesis-level project with oral defense; six-day academic week aligned to the 194-day standard.

Faculty and Integrity

Faculty hold advanced academic degrees and international teaching experience. Major assessments are proctored live with camera-on standards; oral defenses, annotated rubrics, and version histories verify authorship, process, and mastery in compliance with FERPA.

Fast Facts

Type: Nonprofit online college preparatory school.

Grades: 9-12 with standard entry at Grade 9 and selective entry at Grade 10.

Student Body: Small, selective cohorts with individualized mentoring and seminar instruction.

Records: Official transcripts list courses, credits, and GPA (unweighted and weighted) and carry digital signature and counselor verification.
